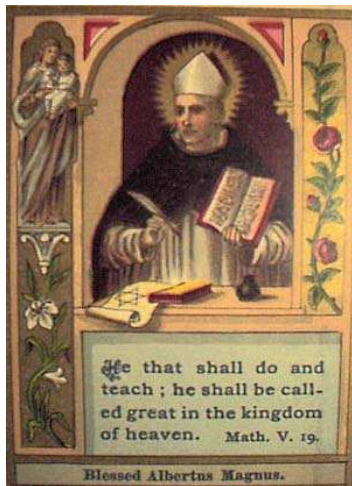

He is Risen! Alleluia, Alleluia!

Today we celebrate with joy our redemption and salvation. Through the suffering, death and resurrection of our Lord, our sins have been forgiven and we have been offered eternal life. Now the hard part . . .

Do you have the courage to accept the offering and live your life with Christ?

I was invited to a family's house. They had been married about 30 years and were having some problems in their married life. We sat at the dining room table sharing a "cup of coffee" as they told me about their problems. They even brought out a picture from their wedding that was in the buffet. When they took out the picture I noticed that in the buffet was also this large pillar candle-their wedding candle. It was almost perfect for after the wedding day as it had never been lit again.

The wedding candle is not a popular fixture at a wedding but for some cultures it plays a very special role. The candle is lit from the couple's baptismal candles and represents their giving the light of Christ to each other and to their marriage. But the candle is to be used, it is supposed to burn down and remind them that they are and will change during their marriage. Just like the candle, they are supposed to change. When a couple decides to have the "wedding" candle as part of their ceremony, they should be planning that on every anniversary, every birthday, they will take the candle out, light it and renew their marriage promise to each other and to their family.

If you don't renew your promises, if you don't relight the flame how can you remember and keep your promises?

Every Easter we relive Jesus' love for us, and are invited to renew our love and commitment to Him.

So what shape is your personal candle in?
