### *From the cluttered Desk of Fr. Kevin,*

Jesus has a tendency to remind us to be unafraid, to trust in Him, to have faith and believe.

The Gospel today takes this to new heights. Jesus reminds Martha that stopping and listening is the better part. But it's not so much the stopping and listening, it's the letting go of all the distractions and worries of life that are keeping us away from God and from each other.

When I was growing up the most important room in the house was the kitchen. Meals were cooked there, food was prepared there, and some of the greatest conversations took place there. My mother was a Martha and she did not want to be left out, so everyone came to her domain. When I was 7, we moved into the "new" house on the farm but dad had to do some fixing up first. He and my uncle built a whole new kitchen for my mom - basically what seemed the largest room in the house, for it became the centre of all activity. Martha needed to know what was going on in her children's lives.

Mom is still a Martha. This weekend we celebrate mom and dad's 55<sup>th</sup> Wedding Anniversary and mom is making the potato salad, since no one makes it the way mom makes it and mom's is the best. Martha will be at her best and will stay up late to hear from all her children. She will rush and fuss, but every one of us will leave knowing mom listened.

Dad of course is the Mary of our lives. He will sit patiently, listen, offer very few words and rarely tell you what to do. But you will know you have been heard. (Unless he takes out his hearing aid.)

There are many Martha's and Mary's in this world and God bless all of them. Still all of us, Martha's or Mary's must remember what is important; staying close to the ones we love, God, family and neighbour.
